# **Old Stratford Parish Council**

#### **Introduction**

This document has been produced to support a grant application on behalf of the Old Stratford Parish Council to provide the village and Passenham with Information Lecterns and Flower Planters. The document outlines a preferred option and estimated costs.

#### **Summary**

Information lecterns will display historical, wild life, flora/fauna and general information relating to the parish plus any unique or unusal facts.

A combination of multi-tiered and pathway planters will be situated at noticable points within the parish.

The cost of Lecterns and planters have been estimated at £8497.60 (Excluding VAT). With an added amount for the installation of lecterns funding required is estimated as £9000.00.

#### Background

Old Stratford has an interesting history; it is an old coaching village, saw action during the Civil War, was situated on the Buckingham arm of the Grand Union Canal and had a busy canal side wharf as well as a light railway. The village also has a nature reserve with an abundance of wildlife.

Passenham is steeped in history with evidence of even Roman occupation. Edward The Elder, son of Alfred the Great, stationed his army there in the 10th Century and the Church of St. Guthlac's was established around this time. Passenham was a royal manor at the time of the Doomsday Book with a mill and meadows recorded.

The implementation of the proposed information lecterns will provide local residents and passing visitors with historical and general information relating to the parish. This will increase interest and greatly enhance the experience of walking in the area and also provide educational data.

Old Stratford is situated on the old Roman Watling Way, the journey through the village is a little uneventful and the positioning of flower planters would greatly enhance its appearance.

#### **Proposal**

Three A1 information lecterns will display historical, wild life, flora/fauna and general information relating to the village plus any unique or unusal facts.

Two multi-tiered and eight pathway planters will be situated at noticable points in the village.
